Grants

Grants made in the second half of 2021 included:

- £4,051 (cost shared equally with CW+) to the **Training and Education Department** for a scoop hoist for use in training on moving and handling patients
- £3,130 (cost shared equally with CW+) to **Rainsford Mowlem** and **Nell Gwynne** Wards for two ice machines.
 - £1,013 to the **Hand Therapy Team** for a Woodcast oven for making biodegradable splints

We were also able to make progress on the **Butterfly Room project**, which had been on hold since March 2020 due to Covid. In September 2021 we approved funding for four further Butterfly Rooms at West Middlesex Hospital, and work on the first of these has already begun. The Butterfly Room project is now fully funded, and we will be announcing our new major fundraising target shortly.
